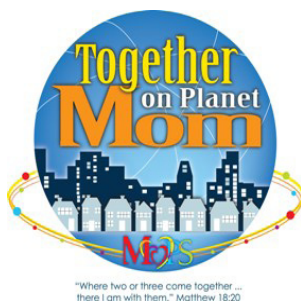
## MOPS *mothers of preschoolers*
